However, a major challenge is developing enough pipeline infrastructure to move these volumes of gas to demand centers.

“A number of projects to move gas out of the Marcellus are under way and expected to be completed over the next few years,” said [Ed Baker](#), partner and co-leader of ScottMadden’s nuclear and gas practices. “The ‘uncorked’ gas will likely have knock-on effects on already low natural gas prices, not merely in the Mid-Atlantic, but south and west as well.”
